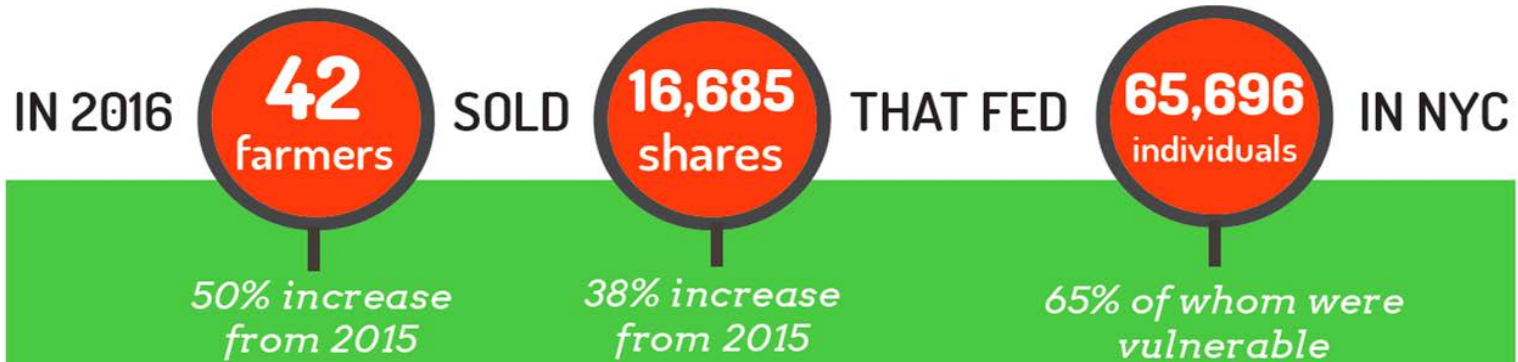

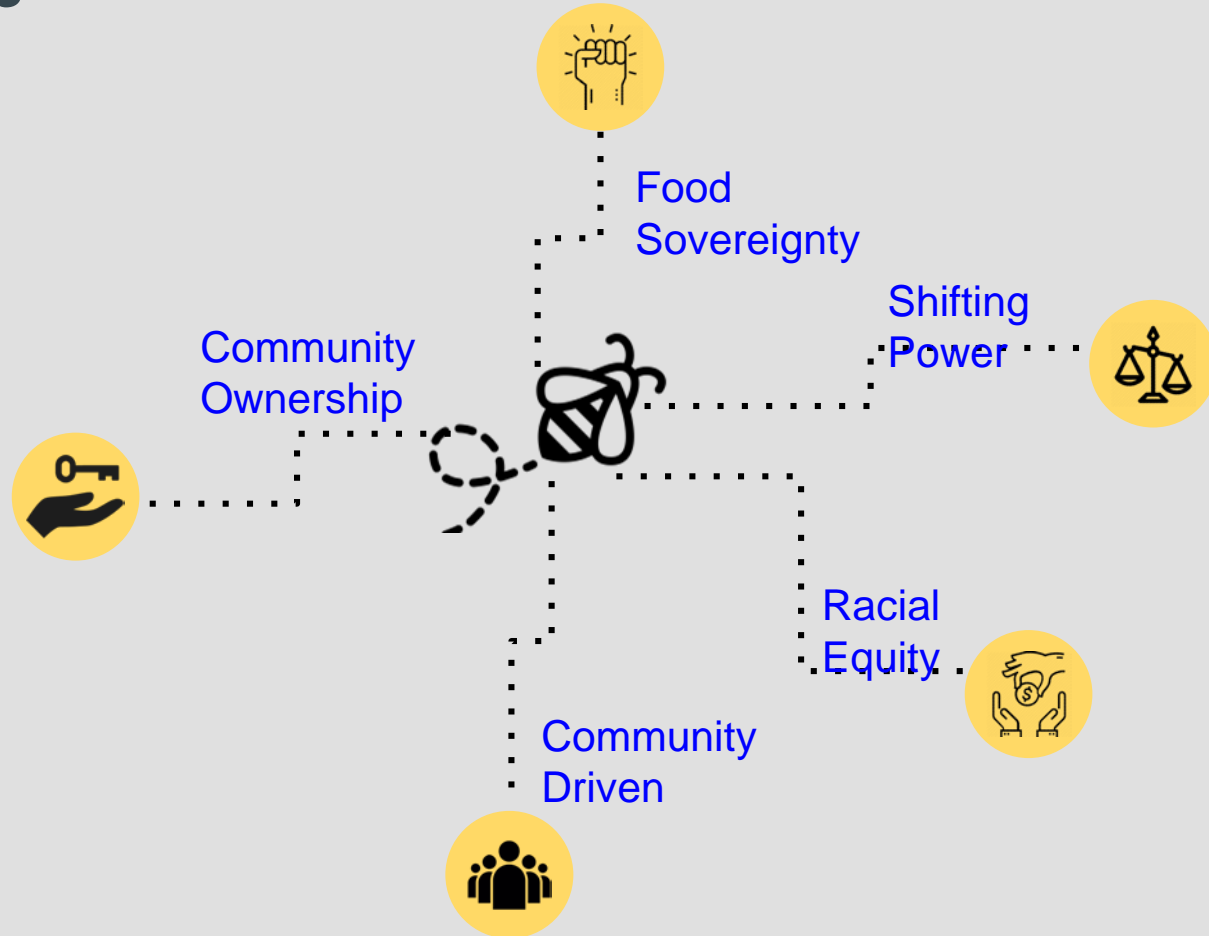


How does Corbin Hill achieve its mission?

Flexibility is Key

- Summer season: June-November
- If you pay for full season upfront, you get a 2% discount
- Pay one week in advance
- Pay monthly
- Put your share on hold
- Automatic payments
- Pay using cash, check, debit/credit, EBT, SNAP, and Health Bucks
- Send a friend to pick up your share
- Sign up and manage your account online
- If your share is not picked up, it is donated to a local food pantry

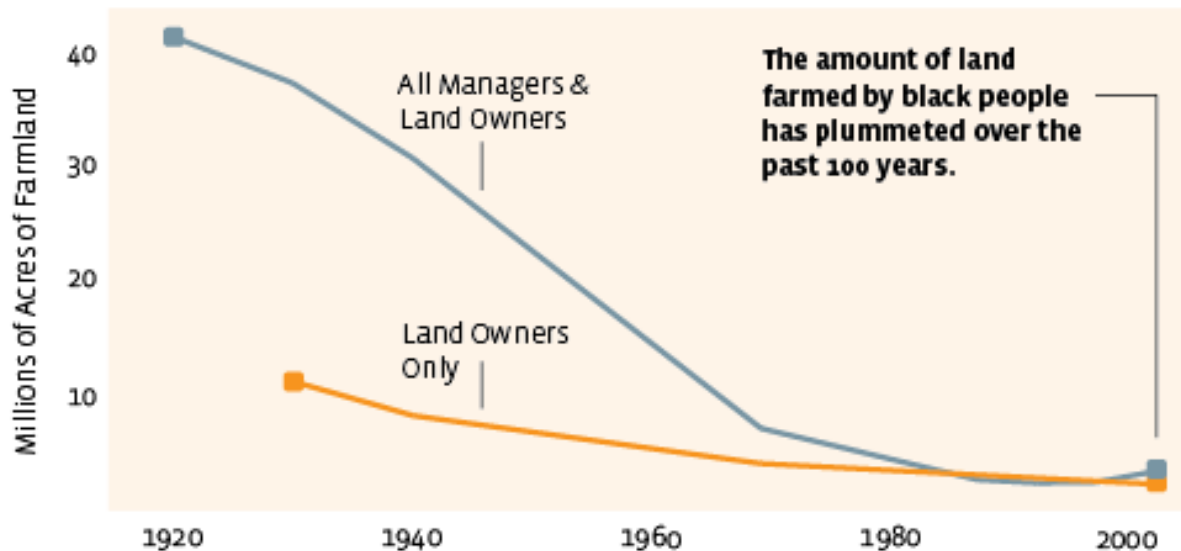

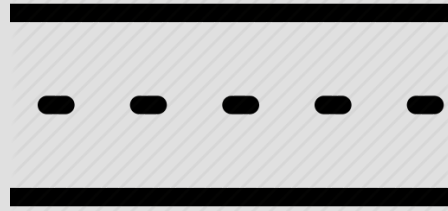
