


#### **How does Corbin Hill achieve its mission?**

## Flexibility is Key

- → Summer season: June-November
- → If you pay for full season upfront, you get a 2% discount
- → Pay one week in advance
- → Pay monthly
- → Put your share on hold
- → Automatic payments
- → Pay using cash, check, debit/credit, EBT, SNAP, and Health Bucks
- → Send a friend to pick up your share
- → Sign up and manage your account online
- → If your share is not picked up, it is donated to a local food pantry


